- ReliOn brand insulins are *NOT eligible* Select Insulins.
- While all formularies will have Select Insulins in Tier 3, Humana’s “Plus” formularies have Select Insulins in Tiers 2 & 3
  - Tier 2 insulins highlighted in *plum*
